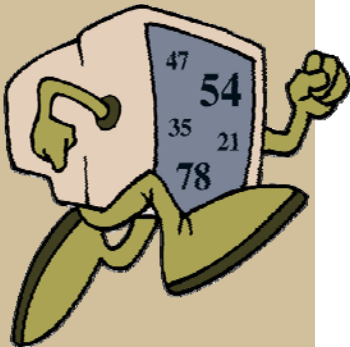

# Hometown Heroes

*Three Collier Deputies Will Be Honored With Phoenix Awards*

Three CCSO deputies will be honored later this month with the prestigious Phoenix Award from the Collier County Bureau of Emergency Services.

They will be recognized June 26 at 9 a.m. at the Board of County Commissioners meeting.

On March 24, Deputies Andrew Drew and Nicholas Shaffer were the first to arrive at a medical call at a pool in North Naples. They placed the automated external defibrillator on the woman and she was shocked twice. They continued with CPR until EMS arrived and took over. The patient recovered.

On March 1, Cpl. Sylee Wagganer was at a medical call in Golden Gate with EMS. As the patient was being prepared to be transported to the hospital, she went into full cardiac arrest. Cpl. Wagganer assisted EMS with equipment and patient care. The patient made a full recovery and is scheduled to be at the Phoenix Award presentation.

According to Capt. Les Williams with Collier County EMS, the local Phoenix Awards program was developed in October 1986 to recognize local emergency responders who were involved in the rescue and treatment of a patient who has suffered sudden cardiac arrest and was brought back to life after being found without a pulse.

The award was named after the mythological Phoenix bird that was consumed by fire, later rose renewed from its ashes, and became a symbol of immortality, resurrection and life after death. Usually about twice a year the group is honored in front of the Board of County Commissioners.

# Stay Cool, Stay Safe

Here are some tips to stay safe when school's out and the sun's hot:



**I**f your kids are at home alone during the day, make sure they know not to open the door to anyone they don't know.



**K**ids should never tell anyone, including telling anyone over the phone, that they are home alone.



**C**hildren should know their full names, addresses and phone numbers.



**T**hey should know what to do in case of an emergency and who they should call.



**M**ake sure they stay away from pools and canals when there are no adults present.



**C**hildren should never approach any cars, trucks or vans unless they have an adult with them.



**T**each your children whose cars and homes they are allowed to go into.



**D**on't drop your kids off at the mall, movies, or parks. Always make sure there is a trusted adult there who can supervise them.



**L**et your children know what to do if someone tries to take them. Tell them to yell, scream or do anything to call attention to themselves.

# ? Ask A Deputy ?

**Q:** What are the age and height requirements for a child, to be in a booster seat or car seat on a school bus?

Is the car seat law enforced on a school bus?

**A:** By state law, school buses are exempt from using seat belts and child safety restraints.

However, through Head Start, any child that weighs less than 50 pounds riding on a school bus is required to be in an appropriate child restraint seat, like a portable child safety seat or a safety restraint vest.

Booster seats are not used because they use both the lap and shoulder belt to secure the child. If a bus has seat belts, typically it will only have lap belts.
